Uganda Mission Team

Five members of the Consortium will be heading to Uganda July 26th, along with 4 members from two parishes in Newark (one of them is Fr. Wilson, so we will be traveling over there with a priest!). The Newark group will be staying at Miryante for a couple days, before heading to another orphanage. They hope to be able to share some of the business model used at Miryante to help the other orphanage with their finances.

The projects we are working on for Miryante are:

- expanding the goat barn
- providing water filters for each of the housing units
- purchasing materials for a water irrigation system
- providing funds to build benches for the church recently but on the campus, as well as religious articles

We will also do health checks on the children and we have prepared crafts and activities for various age groups. Deacon Hauser has purchased materials to teach the children how to make rosaries. A field day is also on the schedule. Because we will have a priest (for a few days) and Deacon Hauser, we will be able to have Mass and/or prayer services.

Many people in the parish (and outside the parish!) have made generous donations for the supplies/projects. They are also sending gifts for the children
