I. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible any graduating high school senior must have been accepted by an accredited university, college, or trade school as a full-time student and meet at least one of the following additional qualifications. Be either

- A member of Saint Joseph Parish
- Or the child or grandchild of a member of Council 11759 in good standing without regard to residence
- Or the child or grandchild of a deceased member of Council 11759 who was in good standing at the time of his death without regard to residence

II. SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants for a Knights of Columbus Scholarship shall be judged on the basis of financial need, academic achievement, academic potential, academic honors, and extra-curricular activities (School, Community, and Church.)

- III. APPLICATION AND DOCUMENTATION (NOTE: The applicant may add additional pages for each of the items requested in the application)



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To be considered for a scholarship, a graduating high school senior must:

1. Complete the current (2021-2022) prescribed application, answering all questions.
2. Attach a certified transcript of his or her high school grades.
3. Include a copy of a letter of acceptance from the trade school, college, or university. If an acceptance letter is not available at the time of application, the Council must receive a copy of the letter of acceptance before making an award.
4. All documentation must reach the Committee not later than the announced deadline for application. **Each applicant is responsible to see that the application reaches the Church Office by the deadline. There will be no exceptions!**
