DISCUSSION TOPICS	Dan Rohner, Director of Leadership Development and Pastoral Planning for the archdiocese, was a guest at the meeting. Mr. Rohner noted we should focus on the four priorities areas previously discussed. Our mission should reflect the priorities of the archdiocese, which should reflect the 2000-year traditions of the church, which should reflect the good news of Jesus Christ. Our current mission statement predates the four priorities but addresses three of the four. It is, however, much longer than more-current mission statements. Parishioners must be engaged to feel ownership of the new mission statement.		

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	<p>Fr. Gibbs indicated he feels a sub-committee should be formed to further the mission review process. He does not have a timeline for completion of the process, other than acknowledging that the process will take some time. He didn't think the mission process could be completed prior to Easter.</p> <p>A subcommittee consisting of Fr.
