

Summer Reading

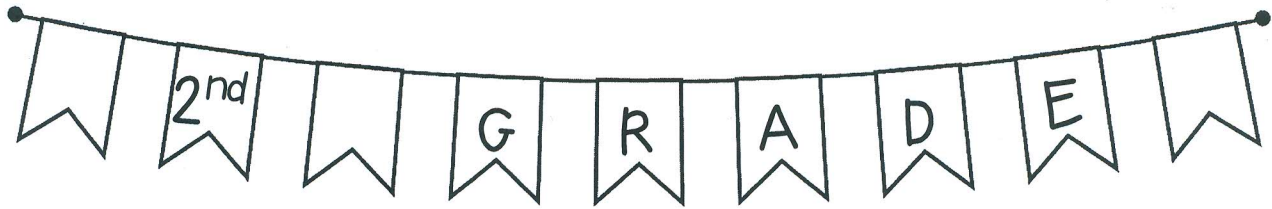
Dear Parents and Families,
