Christmas Program volunteers – match volunteers with music teacher

Vice President – Involvement: recruit volunteers and oversee the following areas

Carnival – chair annual carnival; works closely with Mrs. Bucio; can have two people in this position

Catholic Identity – works to promote our Catholicity throughout the school and community

Dads' Club – Dad/Grandfathers/Uncles/Others who come together to help out with projects around the school that directly benefit students

Spirit Store – works with staff to develop and expand our Spirit Store, virtual and on-campus

Vice President – Athletics: recruit volunteers and oversee the following areas

Booster Club – works with Coach to help coordinate events that will raise funds in direct support of athletics (such as uniforms and supplies)

Volunteer Coordinator – works with Coach to secure volunteers for such things as concessions and facility coverage

YMCA-Youth Liaison – work with Coach to help bring sports to our younger students (up to 4th grade)

Treasurer – works as point person for all PTO funds; track income, receipts, check requests, etc. in coordination with Mrs. Shirley

Secretary – coordinate meeting notes from each sub-group meeting; provide updated reports to Vice Presidents and Teacher Liaisons
