3. Jesus Falls the First Time
4. Jesus Meets His Mother
5. Simon of Cyrene Helps Jesus Carry the Cross
6. Jesus' Face is Wiped by Veronica
7. Jesus Falls a Second Time
8. Jesus Meets the Women of Jerusalem
9. Jesus Falls a Third Time
10. Jesus is Stripped of his Garments
11. Jesus is Crucified
12. Jesus Dies on the Cross
13. Jesus' Body is Taken Down from the Cross
14. Jesus is Laid in the Tomb
