PSR Children's Registration For Approved Catechists & Adult Volunteers:

When you are accepted as a volunteer, you'll receive instructions on how to register your child(ren) for class online. You will receive a confirmation email and tuition statement when they are registered. As you may know, we have over 130 Catechists with about 300 Catechists' children enrolled in our program.

Our reduced fee structure for children of Catechists or Adult Volunteers:

Class Fees: \$30 per child (receiving no sacraments)/\$90 max per family

2nd grade/Sacramental Prep year II child: \$60 (total - includes additional materials & books)

Year I Confirmation Prep child: \$90 (total - includes retreat & materials)

Year II Confirmation prep child: \$60 (total - retreat & materials)

Diocesan Requirements:

All volunteers must complete the Archdiocesan Safe Environment/VIRTUS Training Program and <u>renew every 5 years</u>. You will be notified when it is time to renew.

CATECHIST AGREEMENT

- I will follow the Precepts of the Catholic Church; be a person of faith whose lifestyle bears a witness to the message of the Gospel and Catholic teachings; to be a prayerful, positive, Catholic role model for the students and families.
- I will always support and present the teachings of the Roman Catholic Church as Truth. All class teachings are to be in accordance with the Magisterium of the Roman Catholic Church. The classroom is not a forum for personal beliefs not in conformity with the Magisterium.
- I will make a good faith commitment to have excellent attendance and provide timely notification to the DRE when an absence is necessary. Be in the classroom at least 20 minutes before class to prepare the classroom and greet students.
- Come to each class fully prepared; pray to the Holy Spirit for guidance before preparing class lessons.
- Pray before class, invoking the Holy Spirit to guide your words and actions; begin and end each class praying with your students. Get to know your students; knowing their name is very important to them.
- Make an effort to involve parents by informational letters, homework, and prayer/classroom/project help.
- I will continue my own faith formation through participation at workshops, courses, retreats, bible studies or other avenues.
- Archdiocesan Basic Catechist Certification Requirements. The Archdiocese requires Catechists to be certified. The requirements will be explained during your interview.
- Attend the Mandatory St. Michael's Catechist Orientation/In-service in the beginning of August.
- Attend the Catechist Faith Formation Day in mid-August.
- Attend several Catechist meetings/classes held at St. Michael's during the year.
- Attend Adult Faith Formation programs to continue your ongoing, life-long faith formation.
