Thanksgiving Meal Boxes

This year, we will once again support families in our local community by preparing Thanksgiving meal boxes to be distributed by Catholic Charities Merrimack Valley. Each box will contain a selection of non-perishable Thanksgiving basics, plus a Market Basket gift card so families can purchase perishables or special items for their own unique holiday traditions.

How Can You Help?

1. Donate food items on the list
2. Donate a completed box, with all of the items listed
3. Donate Market Basket gift cards (\$25)
4. Donate cash to purchase items on the list

When and Where Can You Donate?

All donations should be received by noon this Sunday, November 17.

Food items from the list, as well as completed boxes, can be dropped off in the Gathering Space or on top of the Neighbors in Need bin in the vestibule anytime up until noon on Sunday, November 17, when we will prepare everything for delivery to Catholic Charities.

A donation box for cash and gift cards will be available in the Gathering Space during weekend Masses. Cash or gift card donations can also be dropped off in the parish office.

What's in a box?

- Stuffing mix
- Turkey gravy mix
- Bouillon (cubes, powder, jar)
- 2 cans corn
- 2 cans green beans
- 1 bag rice (1-2 lbs.)
- 2 cans beans (e.g., black, pink, gandules)
- Drink mix (e.g., lemonade/iced tea/Kool Aid)
- 1 carton shelf stable milk
- 1 package fruit cups or applesauce
- 1 box pasta
- 1 easy prep dessert (e.g., cake mix & frosting, or pie crust mix w/filling)
- \$25 MB gift card
