

Bishop's Adult Initiative for the Rite of Confirmation 2021

In an effort to "open wide the doors to Christ" for the people of our diocese, permission has been extended for pastors to confirm adults in their parishes on Pentecost. St. Jude, Allen, invites our practicing adult Catholics who lack the Sacrament of Confirmation, to be sealed with the fullness of the gift of the Holy Spirit.



In order to attend this class, you must meet the following criteria:

- must be a registered member of St. Jude
- must be a practicing adult in good standing (18 years of age, out of high school)
- if married, must be married in the church
- must have already received the sacrament of Baptism and Eucharist and
- must provide a current (within 6 months) Baptismal Certificate from church of Baptism with notations
- must have a sponsor (the parish can help if needed)
- must be able to attend the following virtual **classes: Thursday, May 6th - 7 to 9 pm in the Lecture Hall and Thursday, May 13th - 7 to 9 pm via Zoom. Facilitator: Dave Catlett. Zoom link will be provided after registration is received.**

Sponsors are welcome to attend classes, although it is not required. Sponsors must meet the following requirements:

- he or she must be a baptized Catholic who has received the Eucharist and Confirmation
- currently living a sacramental life (e.g., attending Mass regularly)
- if married, in a marriage recognized by the Catholic Church
