- 1) What is a phrase you say that you picked up from one of your parents?
- 2) In the 1<sup>st</sup> reading (Deut 4:32-34, 39-40), Moses recalls all the ways God has helped his chosen people, and in the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading (Rom 8:14-17), St. Paul tells us we can call God Abba (or Father). Do you think of God as a father who personally leads and guides you, intervenes on your behalf, and considers you a beloved son or daughter? If not, what is your impression of God?
- 3) Last week we talked about several qualities that greatly help faith conversations:
  - Listening without judgement
  - Not forcing a conclusion
  - Showing interest in the other person's concerns
  - Asking good questionsIf you practiced any of these skills this week, how did it go?
- 4) What are some things you should avoid saying when talking to Bowie Bob or Barb? Why are they not helpful?
- 5) Fr. Mike suggested several questions you could ask about the pandemic that might both feel natural and lead to talking about faith. Brainstorm several more of these questions that are not pandemic-related.
- 6) Is your Bowie Bob/Bowie Barb unchurched or de-churched? How will this affect how you enter into conversation with them?
