- 1) When you were a kid, did you ever promise to do something with your fingers crossed behind your back? Do you ever do that now?
- 2) Have you started making plans for the summer and fall? How confident are you that they will happen?
- 3) Outside your family, who do you trust the most?
- 4) When you hear the word faith, do you primarily associate that with a) a set of beliefs or b) trust in God/Jesus? Why?
- 5) On a scale of 1 to 5, how strongly do you trust that God has a plan for your life and is concerned about your personal welfare?
- 6) If you have ever planted anything from a seed, how much control did you have over whether it grew or not? Did you have a sense that God had a part in that growth?
- 7) In this week's second reading (2 Cor 5:6-10) St. Paul reminds us that we walk by faith and not by sight. Share a practical example from your life of how you do this.
- 8) Which would you rather live out – your own plan for your life or God's plan for your life? Why?
- 9) Fr. Mike mentioned several prayers we could pray – from asking for the grace to keep seeking out God's plan rather than our own, to asking God "show me the next step in your plan," to the simple prayer "God if you are real, please let me know." Which of these do you need to pray this week to increase your trust in God?
