- 1) What is something you have faith in because it is consistent or reliable? Who is someone you have faith in for the same reasons?
- 2) Have you ever witnessed or benefitted from a miraculous healing? What happened?
- 3) Do you think God still heals today?
- 4) Jesus seems to connect faith with the two healings we hear about in this week's Gospel (Mk 5:21-43).
  - a. How does the depth of the person's faith seem to matter?
  - b. When you ask for healing does the depth of your faith make a difference? Why or why not?
- 5) Has God ever brought healing in a way that was different from what you were asking for?
- 6) Fr. Mike mentioned that Jesus didn't heal every sick person or raise every dead person. Why does God allow sickness and death?
- 7) Has a lack of a response to your prayer ever caused you to doubt God or his love for you? How can you have greater faith in a God who can heal, but doesn't always choose to?
- 8) Throughout this message series, we have heard that as disciples we are called to surrender everything to God – our hopes, our dreams, our lives, our fears, our failings, and our pain. What might you need to surrender to God this month? What steps can you take to do so?
