SMALL GROUP LEADER

Small Group Leaders invest in the lives of a few to encourage authentic faith. The content and all materials are provided by the Confirmation Prep Team. The Small Group Leaders role is to facilitate relationships with the few you have been entrusted with. **Saturdays about once a month 6:45 – 8:45 pm**



WINS

You win when teens have meaningful interactions during the group that influence their faith in Jesus and deepen their relationships with others.

CHARACTERISTICS

Facilitator

Small Groups Leaders facilitate discussion among their few so that they are able to wrestle with life's big questions in a faith-based environment. In order to lead their few, Small Group Leaders are open to continually growing in knowledge of our faith, their personal prayer life and tools to help them connect with their few. Small Group Leaders model active listening skills and create an environment where teens are free to be the unique person God has created them to be.

Disciple

Small Group Leaders are able to lead their few to be a in a growing relationship with Jesus because they are consistently growing in their own. As appropriate, they share what their own faith journey is like with their few as example of what a life of discipleship looks like. Small Group Leaders are encouraged to be a part of an Adult Small Group for their own accountability.

Partner

Adult Leaders partner with the parents of their few. Teens have the best chance of life-long authentic faith when the Church and Home work together. Adult Leaders support parents in their role as primary educators in faith for their teens.

QUALIFICATIONS

You love God and are actively practicing your faith at SPX through weekly Mass, regular reception of the Sacraments, and modeling the life of a disciple.

You care about teens.

You're committed to consistently investing in and caring for your few over a period of time.

You believe that teens grow in authentic faith best when we partner with parents.

You are VIRTUS certified or are willing to become certified at Church expense.

EXPECTATIONS

Lead Small.

BE PRESENT: Connect their faith to a community by showing up predictably, mentally, and randomly.

CREATE A SAFE PLACE: Clarify their faith as they grow by leading the group, respecting the process, and guarding the heart.

PARTNER WITH PARENTS: Nurture an everyday faith by cueing the parent, honoring the parent, and reinforcing the family.

MAKE IT PERSONAL: Inspire their faith by your example by living in community, setting priorities, and being real.

MOVE THEM OUT: Engage their faith in a bigger story by moving them to someone else, moving them to be the church, and moving them to what's next.

Be reliable.

Our Sacramental Prep process draws from a number of resources and reflects the philosophy of all our Kids & Student Programs. It's important that we are all on the same page and follow the plan so that we speak to the kids with a unified voice.

Commit to being present each Saturday, when at all possible. Your few are counting on you!

Communicate with the Kids & Student Coordinator in advance if your plans change.

Give your all.

Show up on time.

Check your email weekly to look over information provided by the Kids & Student Coordinator.

Come prepared to engage in the activity with the teens.

Attend the appropriate training events and meetings.

Wear the t-shirt provided for you.

Come well rested. We need your best energy.

ORIENTATION & TRAINING

Small Group Leaders will participate in training before starting each year.

EQUIPPING & ENCOURAGEMENT

The Sacramental prep Team will provide opportunities for growing in your role through sharing articles, blogs, and in person events on a regular basis. The Sacramental Prep Team is always available to provide support.

ATTIRE

T-shirts are provided so that the Team is clearly identified for anyone entering the space. We ask that t-shirts are worn at every event with whatever other modest clothes you like.

VOLUNTEER IDENTIFICATION AND APPLICATION
