- Have supplies ready and in the appropriate rooms and spaces each week.

- Ensure the space you are responsible for is clean and in order.

- Treat every teen like they're the most important guest of the day.

- Look for, and engage, teens who may be new, lost or alone.

- Give visitors and first-time guests the VIP treatment.

- Attend the appropriate training events and meetings.

The Host Team will participate in training before starting each year.

EQUIPPING & ENCOURAGEMENT

The HSM Team will provide opportunities for growing in your role through sharing articles, blogs, and in person events on a regular basis. The HSM Team is always available to provide support.
