- Ensure the space you are responsible for is clean and in order.

- Treat every kid like they're the most important guest of the day.

- Look for, and engage, kids who may be new, lost or alone.

- Give visitors and first-time guests the VIP treatment.

- Attend the appropriate training events and meetings.
