School Closures and Late Starts

The first rule for parents, students and staff is to be safe.

We follow the Sherwood School District for school closures and late starts due to icy conditions. We will send out an email if possible. We also use FlashAlert. This allows us to show up on the news media websites. We have found that the TV news tends to break for commercials when they get to the “s” so they aren’t the best source of information. You can sign up to receive FlashAlert messages by going to flashalert.net and under the Manage Your Messages tab create an account. If school is 2 hours late, there is no before school care. If we have to close school during the day we will send out emails and text messages using SchoolSpeak.
