## **First Day of School**

We are looking forward to seeing everyone on the first day of school, Tuesday, September 3rd. A reminder about drop off procedures for students in K-8: students arriving before 8:00 am should report to the library. Before school care is 7:00 am -8:00 am in the library. The cost is \$5/day per student. You will be billed through FACTS. All other students should be dropped off in carline (drive around the church, parish hall and school , (around the outside of the island with trees), until you reach the double doors between the school and the gym.) PreK will be using the space between the island with trees and the school for their drop off. On the first day of school, parents are welcome to park and walk in with their students starting at 8:00 am. School begins at 8:15 am.

**Things to Know** (that I may not have told you yet).

Students will need to bring a lunch and snack every day. Milk and hot lunches will not be available yet. Only students in grades 5-8 are allowed to use a microwave at lunch. After school care does not begin until Wednesday, September 4th. (More information will be sent out.)

Forms: The Use of the Field Form is required for all students so that we can take them to the public school field next door for PE and other activities. The Media Release Form only needs to be returned if there are restrictions on using your child's picture in different medias (classroom, auction, parish bulletin, etc.) The Walking Form is only if your student has permission to walk home or to the library after school. All medications must be turned into the office in original containers and with a Medication Form. All forms are available on SchoolSpeak.
