PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

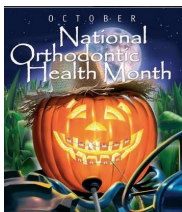

HALLOWEEN CELEBRATION

The students will be able to dress up in their Halloween costumes on Tuesday, October 26th.

Each class will do their own contained party

If your child does not want to dress up in a costume, they may come in Free-Dress, following the free-dress guidelines found on the family handbook.

1. All school costume guidelines:

- a. No blood, gore or weapons
- b. Students may not wear anything suggestive or seductive. Students may not show a bare midriff; tummy; torso, including cleavage; and any dress with narrow straps that exposes the shoulders.
- c. Full-face Halloween masks can be brought to show but not worn in class.
- d. Hair color: if the costume includes dyeing the hair, it must be done at home. It may not be done at school. It also must be completely removed before coming back to school.
- e. Props (baskets, wands, stuffed animals) may be carried during the parade, but must be put away during class

2. Grades PreK - 8th

- a. Costumes should be worn to school in the morning. Please make sure students can sit in the costume comfortably.
- b. Appropriate shoes that students can walk in all day.
- c. Little ones must be able to remove costume by themselves to use the restroom.
