Our “regulars” include a Christian Pastor who leads the way in greeting approaching patrons and in rapid-fire fashion, explains the alternatives to abortion and the merits of visiting a nearby Community Women’s Center for help. Since most patrons are hurried or uneasy, he hands out a bilingual information card which provides contact and website information and provides a brief explanation of free services offered. Those patrons who follow through and make an appointment will enjoy a safe, confidential and non-judgmental consultation. This often leads to an ultrasound scan, parenting skills training, toddler clothing, baby food and even job search preparation and counseling ... all FREE. It is amazing how often the ultrasound scan image will cause the pregnant mother to reverse course and choose life.

These Catholics and other Christians come to Trenton because they love and respect God’s gift of life and detest the taking of innocent life. We pray for the end to abortion and for a change of heart by women contemplating abortion. The power of prayer is responsible for shuttering many baby killing centers throughout the USA. Planned Parenthood Trenton is ground zero for our prayers. To further accomplish this goal, we need more Prayer Warriors: we need you! The area is safe and there’s plenty of free parking. If you feel that the killing of innocent babies is immoral and an offence against our Creator, please give serious thought to join our prayer witness.
