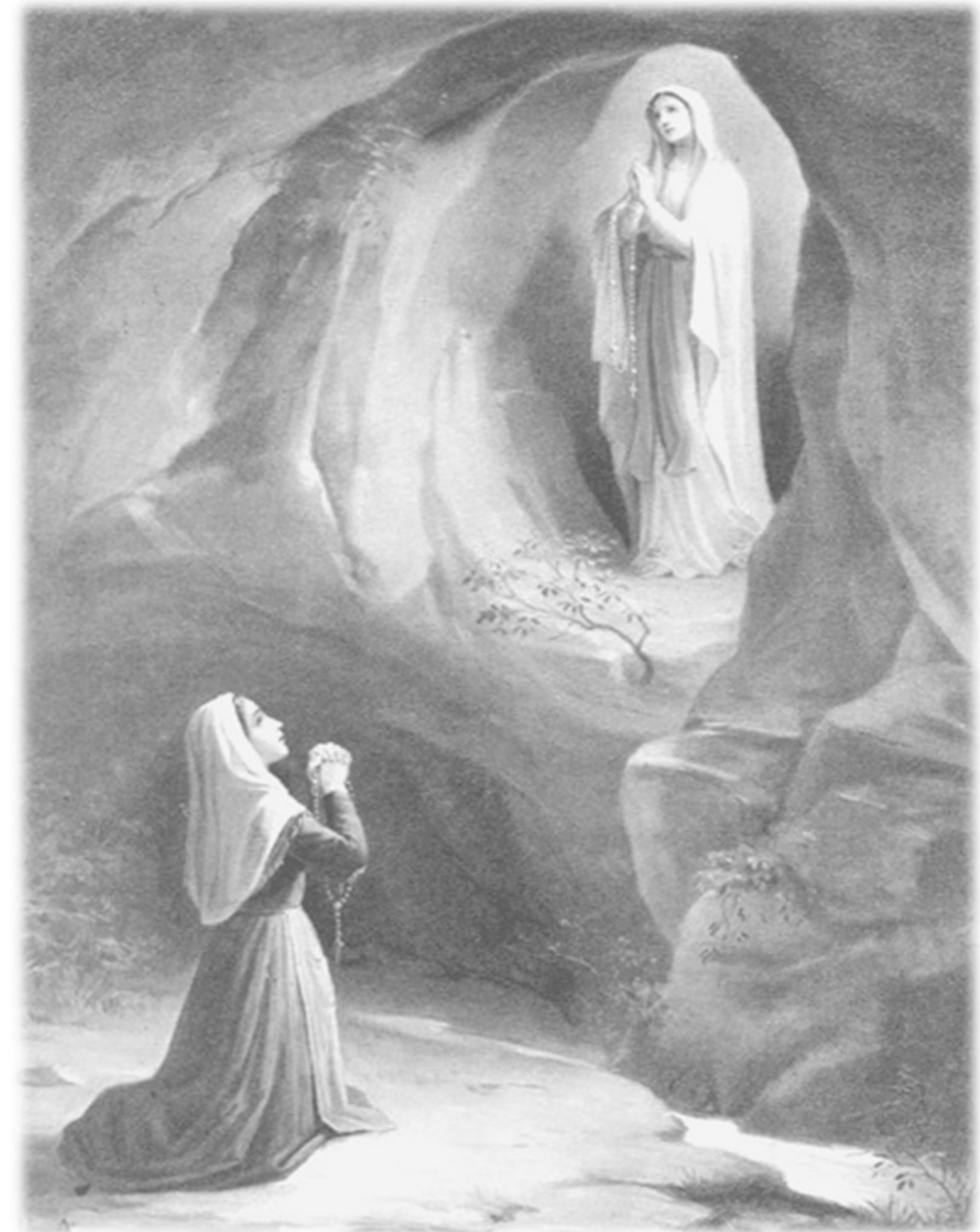

SENIOR CARE SERVICES

Catholic Charities KCSJ's Senior Care Services provide a menu of supportive services for older adults (55+, low income) in neighborhoods where underserved seniors reside. The program provides a comprehensive, client-centered continuum, designed to meet a senior's varying needs. This allows seniors to live a healthy, self-sustaining life in their own home and community. Services may include meal preparation for special diets, cleaning, laundry, shopping, reading, trash disposal, and resource education. Home-based service participation begins with an initial conversation with either the individual or referral source.
