It is my sad duty to inform you, that in compliance with the recently issued emergency order and with direction from Father Holloway, we are closing the Adoration Chapel for at least 30 days, starting at 12:01 am on Tuesday, March 24, 2020.

Please! Do not let this interruption in perpetual adoration at Our Lady of Lourdes become an interruption in your personal prayer life! Our parish, our families, and our community need your prayers now more than ever.

While the length of this closure and the speed with which it came is a shock, we will come out of this and return to perpetual adoration and Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes stronger than we were before. In the words of St. Padre Pio, *pray, hope, and don't worry*. Christ is with us.
