For the most part, each Parish Pastoral Council will meet separately to discuss matters pertaining to each individual parish. But we will also hold joint Parish Pastoral Council meetings to discuss matters that pertain to or impact both parishes. While we are 2 separate parish communities, that also doesn't mean that we have to do everything separate from each other. We won't do every single thing together, each parish community has our own individual history and traditions, but at times we may be able to do some things stronger together rather than separate.

The Parish Pastoral Council is also not a clique, a closed group, or a group consisting of members who have a lifetime appointment. Each member of the Parish Pastoral Council serves for a term-limit and on a regular basis, primarily of 2 years, so we will be regularly looking for new members to step up and take their place. We will have a formal commissioning of our new Parish Pastoral Council in a few weeks as we celebrate the Feast of our Patron Saint, St. Vincent De Paul, and our first rotation of Parish Pastoral Council members sometime in 2021.
