The tasks include cleaning, unlocking the church for mass or funerals, helping seat those attending mass, identifying, and reporting any necessary repairs to the priest. Its normally done by a married couple or even families but is open to any group of parishioners who want to join to serve God and His church. Must be 18yrs or older to apply and attend an online Abuse Awareness training at [www.virtus.org](http://www.virtus.org) The beauty of this ministry is the time spent alone at your church, the one-on-one time with the Lord, a closeness often unattainable in a group setting and praising God while working.
