## Thinking about Baptism?

We ask that the Parents/Godparents Contact the Parish office to see what you need to get started today! Parents/Godparents need to be Registered/Active at a Parish for at least 3 months before baptism.

### WE NEED YOU!

We need new Mayordomos to volunteer to take on the responsibility of caring for the Church!

Responsibilities include:

- Opening the Church for Mass and helping to seat those who attend.
- Disinfecting the church after mass & the weekly Cleaning.
- Taking care of the church grounds by cutting weeds.
- Seasonal Activities: Planning the Annual Bazaar, Preparing the Church for the Lenten, Easter, Advent and Christmas Seasons and the Church's Feast Day.

We need at least 4 groups of Mayordomos to split the responsibility. Each group needs to have at least 2 members. We still need 4 more groups to volunteer.

Is the Lord Calling on you? Mayordomos are how we can help ensure the Church is available when we need it. Without Mayordomos who will open the church for mass or for funerals? Who will help disinfect so we have a safe place to join and worship?

(\*Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age and will need to attend an Abuse Awareness class.)
