Third Sunday of Easter

Acts of the Apostles 3:13-15, 17-19; 1 John 2:1-5a; Luke 24:35-48

The element of surprise is present in nearly all the stories of resurrection appearances. Many times Jesus suddenly appears to one or other person, or to a whole group. He is just there—right now, right in their midst or at their side. This had to be disconcerting. And the narratives indicate the consternation of those to whom he appeared.

Thus Jesus is nearly always depicted as trying to calm them. “Peace to you,” is frequently cited as his initial greeting. They calm down and he can then speak to them, instruct them, and charge them with mission. The mission he gave them he continues to give to the Church today: to bear witness to the joy and power of his resurrection.

Our challenge today is that we are probably too calm. We believe that the Risen One is present to us; that He is in our midst; that His word is for us and not just for the disciples of old. We know this. We believe it. But it would be surprising if our minds were really opened to fully understand, and our hearts were on fire with the message.

Thus we pray, as in today's opening prayer, for the Lord to “strengthen your Church to answer your call.” We need that strength as much now as did the disciples of old.
