## *Fourth Sunday of Easter*

*Acts of the Apostles 4:8-12; 1 John 3:1-2; John 10:11-18*

It's a good feeling to know we are cared for. Being cared for is so basic to human living that people who aren't cared for simply die premature deaths. Sociologists now have "proof" of this, but the human family has known this a long, long time. More primitive and pastoral societies had elaborate ways to assure that no individual would be left abandoned or feel unloved. Modern, advanced societies, such as our own, could learn a great deal from these societies. We advanced nations seem to have little moral compunction to care for the homeless, the abandoned, the neglected, the forsaken, who populate our cities and highways. Voices of protest seldom have major impact to correct such deplorable conditions.

So when the Jewish nation depicted their God as a careful, even compassionate, shepherd, they were making a statement about how they felt about their God, and about what kind of God they wanted God to be. God proved to be that kind of God. (At times God seemed to lapse from being a "Good Shepherd" but it was Israel's lapse and sin that made them feel abandoned—God did not abandon them.)

It was an easy step for Jesus—God's own love incarnate—to declare Himself as the Good Shepherd. Jesus embodied in the flesh the nature of God for us—One who cares for us with an infinite care and love.

Shepherding is not a familiar image to us, but being cared for or not cared for is easy to understand. This "Good Shepherd" Sunday should give us deep feelings of being loved by a God who knows how much we need that love for our well being.
