Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Wisdom 2:12, 17-20; James 3:16-4:3; Mark 9:30-37

Two lines in this week's readings tell us much about the early Church: and tell us much about ourselves today. The first is from James' letter: "Where do the conflicts and disputes among you originate? Is it not your inner cravings. . .?! And in the gospel Jesus asks the disciples, "What were you discussing on the way home? At this they fell silent, for on the way they had been arguing about who was the most important."

Almost every family, nearly every faculty and pastoral team, just about every community, whenever and wherever there have been arguments and disputes it had to do with: "Who's in charge!" The questions of craving power and influence, of wanting to be in charge and of having authority are not easily faced among humans. And never have been. There is self-importance that comes with being in charge of something or of some project or of others. And the greater the charge the greater the importance one can attach to the self. "He/she must really be big shot—look at all the positions she/he has!"

"Not so," says Jesus, "not so." In his word and by his life and ignominious death, Jesus tries to reverse our thinking on rank and importance.

"If anyone wishes to rank first, he must remain the last one of all and the servant of all." A simple lesson, but very hard to learn and live. Even after 2000 years of Church history we have a long way to go to get this lesson fully in place.

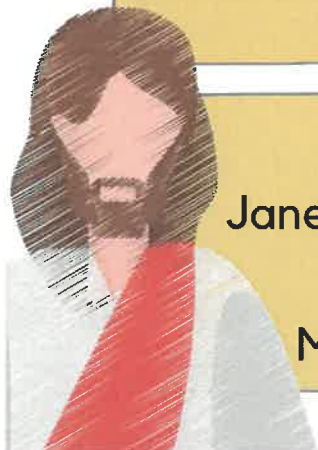
