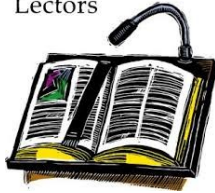

Lectors



A lector/reader is someone who reads the announcements, petitions and readings. They are usually paired with another person to split the responsibilities. (4th grade and older.)

A greeter is someone, or a family, who says "hello" to people as they walk in for Mass. Greeters are also usually paired with someone else. (4th grade and older.)

An usher is responsible for showing people where things are and where to go in an emergency. They are also someone who gathers the collection. (4th grade and older.)

A cantor/musician is someone who picks out the music for the Mass and leads the congregation in singing the songs and responses for the Mass. Cantors can pair up or sing by themselves. They are also welcome to join a choir. (4th grade and older.)

A host family carries the bread and wine, as well as the monetary collection, to Father.

A Eucharistic Minister helps the priest distribute the Body and Blood of Christ to those in attendance at the Mass. They may also take the Eucharist to those who are ill or otherwise unable to attend. (Must be a Confirmed Catholic to be a Eucharistic Minister.)
