### Resumption of Holy Mass at 25% Capacity

Our Lady of Hope church is resuming the public celebration of all weekday and Sunday Masses at 25% capacity (125 people). Your patience and cooperation are kindly requested as we take this important step in fully restoring parish life and activity.

#### Mass Schedule

Monday—Friday: 7:30 am & 9:00 am

Saturday: 9:00 am & 5:00 pm (Vigil Mass)

Sunday: 8:00 am, 9:30 am, 11:00 am, 12:30 pm & 6:30 pm

#### Directive to be observed:

- Parishioners who are elderly and those with compromised immune systems or any serious illness are encouraged to participate in Mass from home;
- Ushers will assist parishioners with seating at all Sunday Masses;
- All parishioners should make use of personal hand sanitizer;
- Social distancing guidelines should be observed at all times while in the church;
- For the time being the parish will not utilize altar servers or extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion;
- Music ministry will be limited to funerals and memorial Masses for the month of July;
- Face covering must be worn at all time while attending Mass. They can be lowered to receive Communion after the minister has placed the consecrated host in your hands;
- Parishioners are requested to depart from the church following the conclusion of Mass to allow the cleaning and preparation of the church for the next Mass;
- There is no exchange of peace and no holding hands during the Lord's Prayer;
- Please do not leave any personal or devotional items in the church;
- Bathrooms and the cry room will not be accessible until further notice.
- Holy Communion will be distributed by the priests and deacons. Communion should be received in the hand;
- **Reminder:** no one is obligated to receive Communion at every Mass.
