

We are infused with the Holy Spirit.

2000 years ago, the apostles were infused with the Holy Spirit. Today we receive the Holy Spirit at baptism. The Holy Spirit dwells within us & helps us with our mission as disciples of Jesus. We never have to worry about leaving the Holy Spirit on the kitchen counter. And the Holy Spirit doesn't need new apps for better functionality. The Holy Spirit is our moral compass for making right choices. The Holy Spirit is a direct line for keeping in touch with God. And the Holy Spirit allows us to see Christ in everyone we meet.

How many times a day do we check with the Holy Spirit for advice? Imagine what kind of place the world could be if we did that even half as many times as we check our phones! And the next time you think your phone is vibrating or ringing and it's not, check with the Holy Spirit. Perhaps we are being nudged to "recalculate" our words/thoughts/deeds so we get back on the right path to our salvation.

The Spirit of Knowledge - that I may know God and know myself, and grow perfect in the science of the saints.

The Spirit of Piety - that I may find the service of God sweet & amiable.

The Spirit of Fear - that I may be filled with a loving reverence toward God & may avoid anything that may displease Him.

- 1 HE IS A PERSON**
The Holy Spirit is the third Person of the Trinity.
- 2 HE IS FULLY GOD**
All three persons of the Trinity are fully God and "equal in glory".
- 3 HE HAS ALWAYS EXISTED**
God eternally exists as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit.
- 4 YOU RECEIVE HIM AT BAPTISM AND CONFIRMATION**
We receive Him first in Baptism, and then is strengthened in the gifts of the Holy Spirit at Confirmation.
- 5 CHRISTIANS ARE TEMPLES OF THE HOLY SPIRIT**
We have the Holy Spirit indwelling in us. We must live accordingly.

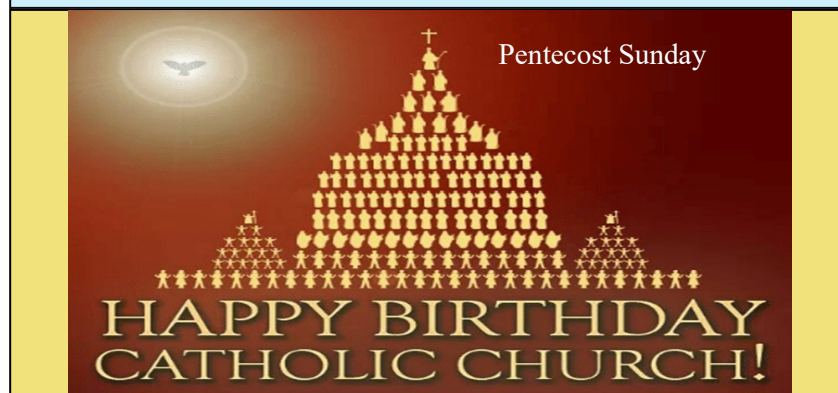
When? Women's Retreat July 17-20th; Men's Retreat July 21-24th
