Picture Directories will only be given to those who participate.

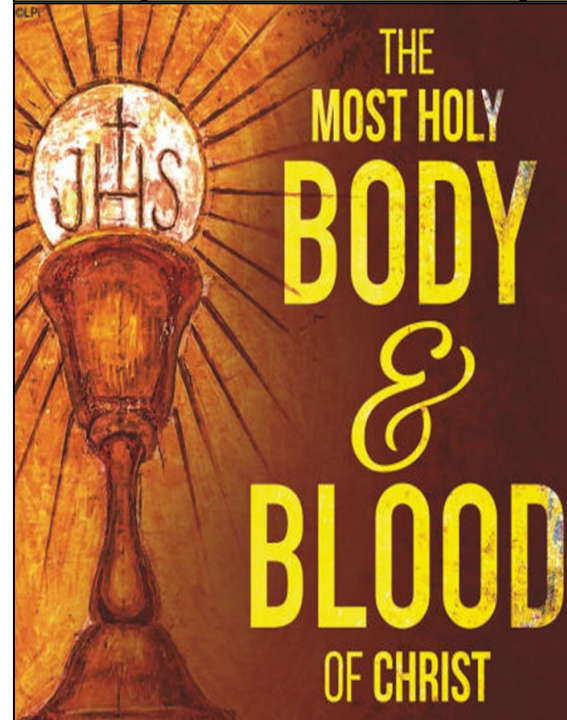
Points to ponder:

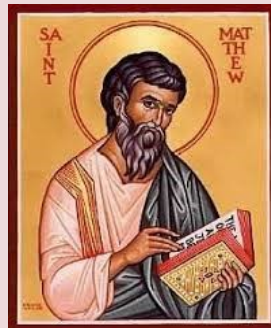

Fraud Alert

There have been several attempts in the country to use priests or parish emails for fraud attempts. In a nutshell this is how it works:

1. The fraudster typically looks at the parish website, and chooses the lead pastor to impersonate.
2. If the lead pastor is "Msgr. John Doe" a fake email like John.Doe28@ gmail.com or PastorJohn87@ gmail.com is setup; the name used on the account is "Msgr. John Doe".
3. The fraudster runs a quick script on the parish website, & harvests all email addresses listed, including ones published in all bulletins.
4. The first email is sent from the fake gmail account "hey are you around do you have a few minutes, I need a quick favor"
5. Non suspecting people, that don't catch the fake gmail account, respond to "Fr." and often times do as instructed.

Tips: Look for emails coming from "fargodiocese.org" email addresses. Fr. Pfeifer will not be requesting gift cards via email.
