I would like to give a special shout-out to thank all of you who contributed to our Annual Pastoral Appeal from the Bishop. Our goal for last year was set by the Bishop at \$107,500. If we do not make our goal, then we are required to take out a loan and pay it off. These are the rules of the Diocese. The government has a federal tax that we are required by law to pay. The Church has a tax that we are required by law to pay.

The APA is predominately used for; The Catholic Radio Station (Spirit FM), Catholic Charities, the Catholic Homeless Shelters, the Seminary, the Pro-Life office, the Prison Ministry and the Pastoral Center. The Pastoral Center covers all the legal, accounting, construction, multi-cultural functions, vocations for the diocese, and also the Bishop's office. The Diocese consists of five counties; Hillsborough, Pinellas, Citrus, Hernando and Pasco.

For those of you who did not contribute to our APA goal than you did not contribute to those important functions of the church. When you see a homeless person, remember that you '**did not**' provide shelter, clothing, or food for them. When you listen to Spirit FM, remember that you '**did not**' contribute to support it. Regarding all the facets of APA, you '**did not**' contribute.

We are called to 'tithe'. All of us are not to neglect this important command from God. I ask that you prayerfully consider donating 5% of your income to your parish. Many people donate only 5% of one hour of work to us. How do they think we are supposed to survive as a parish? Perhaps it would be best for me to have public finance meetings in the Duffy Hall twice a year to educate people on the costs of running this parish. Let me know.

We do have some faithful people that deserve a special pat on the back from God. Without those people, we would close our doors. As someone who loves the Church, thank-you for joining together to make this important goal.

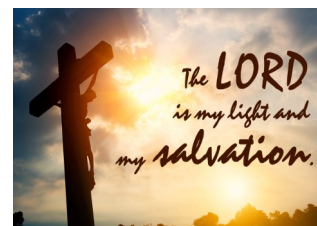
