January 24, 2021 - 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

## The Resurrection Window (Week 1)

The window is magnificent. It measures in at 20 ft wide and 40 ft high. (This is the top 2/3 of the window. Next week, I'll show the bottom). This window is all faceted stone. They have all been cut with precision. The light shines through brilliantly.



1) Immediately, you'll notice the Trinitarian Aspect of the window. The hand of God the Father, the creator of the sun, the moon, and the stars is about to embrace the pierced right hand of His Son.

2) The Holy Spirit, symbolized by the dove and fire, is about to make contact with the pierced left hand of the Son. You'll notice the succession of the Persons. First the Father, then the Son, and finally revealed is the Holy Spirit.



3) Christ is bursting out of the darkness with supernatural power and light. He's got the Power!!! He wears a white tunic with a scarlet red overlay cloth. Innocent blood (white/red) is a common theme for the cost of our salvation. The darkness of death has been defeated.

4) Beneath Christ is 'The Vine and the Branches'. The theme that the parishioners wanted to be displayed on this massive window is from John 15:1-17. Christ says, "Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me." That is the message the people put forth here in the mid-70s. They want all future onlookers to remain in Jesus and to bear good fruit.

5) Only three of the four evangelists were included on the window. I do not understand why Matthew, the angel is not included here. But you will notice the Eagle (John), the Bull (Luke), and the Lion (Mark) all nestled within the vine and all seem to fall under Christ.

6) The Eagle takes the highest position on the branch, being the closest to Christ and reminding us of John's position at the Last Supper. The bloody feet of Christ seem to be resting on the Bull and the Lion. It reminds us of Mary the sister of Martha. Christ complimented her because she sat at his feet. It implies one who is willing to listen and then walk in His footsteps. Luke and Mark teach us to walk with Jesus. John teaches us to fly with Jesus.
