



Wedding Protocols for The Chapel of St. Thérèse

1. Maximum capacity in the Chapel of St. Thérèse is 50 people; inclusive of the priest, choir, lector, hospitality ministers, minister of Holy Communion / sacristan; and videographer for livestream.
Anyone not able to enter the Chapel may watch via livestream on:

2. Access into the Chapel of St. Thérèse is through the west wing entrance **ONLY** (Plaza side).
3. Temperatures will be taken prior to entering the Chapel.
Temperatures of 99.9F will be advised not to enter.
4. The faithful are required to wear a mask upon entering the Chapel and must be kept in place for the duration of the Celebration except when receiving Holy Communion.
5. The faithful are advised to find their seats, starting at the front of the Chapel, while observing proper social distancing. Members of the same household can sit together.
6. For your convenience, hand sanitizers are available at the entrance of the Chapel.
7. There will be no entrance procession with entourage with exception of the bride and her father.

8. Members of the entourage will already be in their seats prior to the beginning of the Mass.
9. There will be no offertory procession.
10. Distribution of Holy Communion will take place at the usual time. Please be guided by the Ministers of Hospitality and observe the proper distance of 6 feet if you are not in the same household.
11. Communion can be received either by tongue or by hand; kindly remove gloves if you are wearing one.
12. After Mass, exit will be through both doors on the east (lanai side) and the west (Plaza side).
13. Only those who are getting photos taken will be allowed back in the Chapel. Photo timeline is 15 minutes.
14. Bathroom facilities are not available.
