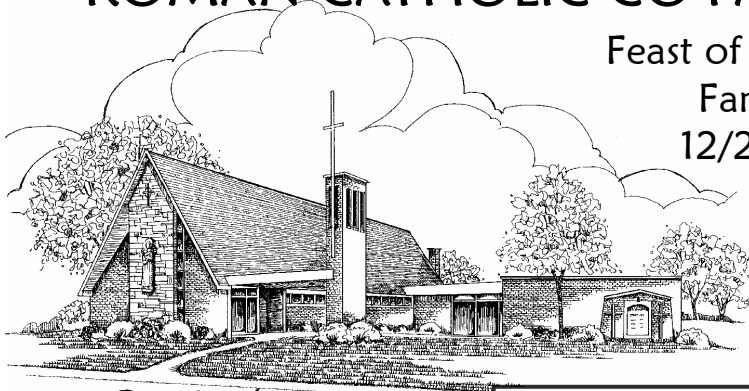
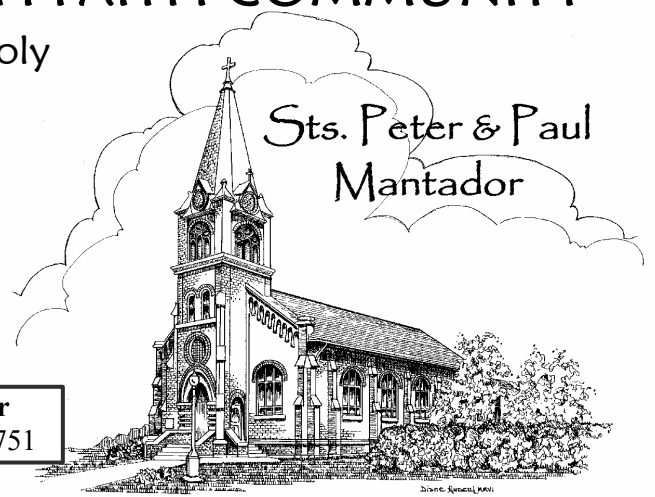

Christmas is an octave (8 days) and a season (to Dec 12)

FROM 1558 UNTIL 1829, ROMAN CATHOLICS IN ENGLAND WERE NOT PERMITTED TO PRACTICE THEIR FAITH OPENLY. SOMEONE DURING THAT ERA WROTE THIS CAROL AS A CATECHISM SONG FOR YOUNG CATHOLICS. IT HAS TWO LEVELS OF MEANING: THE SURFACE MEANING PLUS A HIDDEN MEANING KNOWN ONLY TO MEMBERS OF THEIR CHURCH. EACH ELEMENT IN THE CAROL HAS A CODE WORD FOR A RELIGIOUS REALITY WHICH THE CHILDREN COULD REMEMBER.

THE PARTRIDGE IN A PEAR TREE WAS JESUS CHRIST.

TWO TURTLE DOVES WERE THE OLD AND NEW TESTAMENTS

THE EIGHT MAIDS A-MILKING WERE THE EIGHT BEATITUDES.

THREE FRENCH HENS STOOD FOR FAITH, HOPE AND LOVE.

NINE LADIES DANCING WERE THE NINE FRUITS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT--LOVE, JOY, PEACE, PATIENCE, KINDNESS, GOODNESS, FAITHFULNESS, GENTLENESS, AND SELF CONTROL.

THE FOUR CALLING BIRDS WERE THE FOUR GOSPELS OF MATTHEW, MARK, LUKE & JOHN.

THE FIVE GOLDEN RINGS RECALLED THE TORAH OR LAW, THE FIRST FIVE BOOKS OF THE OLD TESTAMENT.

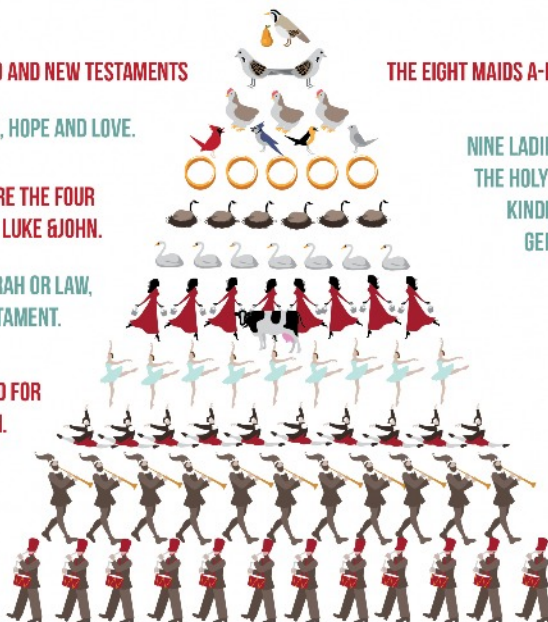
THE TEN LORDS A-LEAPING WERE THE TEN COMMANDMENTS.

THE SIX GEESSE A-LAYING STOOD FOR THE SIX DAYS OF CREATION.

THE ELEVEN PIPERS PIPING STOOD FOR THE ELEVEN FAITHFUL DISCIPLES.

SEVEN SWANS A-SWIMMING REPRESENTED THE SEVENFOLD GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT--PROPHESY, SERVING, TEACHING, EXHORTATION, CONTRIBUTION, LEADERSHIP, AND MERCY.

THE TWELVE DRUMMERS DRUMMING SYMBOLIZED THE TWELVE POINTS OF BELIEF IN THE APOSTLES' CREED.

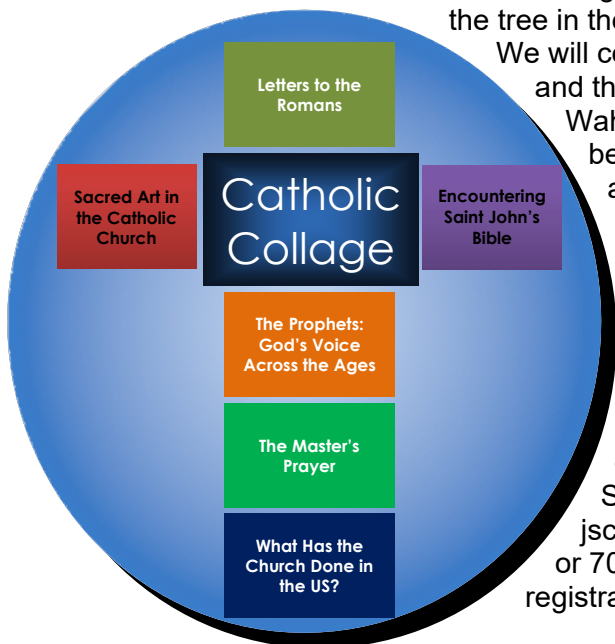
Socks & mittens for homeless - Please bring donations of socks & mittens for adults or youth and hang them on the tree in the entrance of the church at St Anthony.
