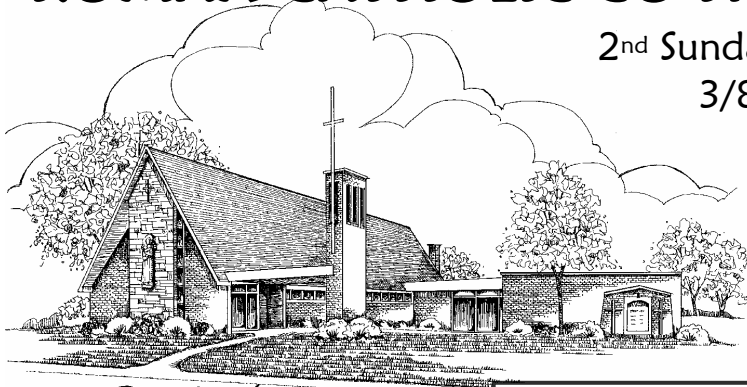


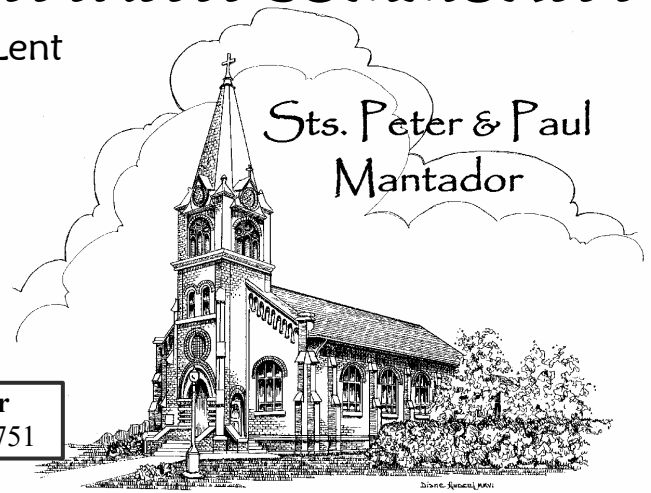

Following up from last week's Safe Haven Sunday

Last week I wrote in the bulletin of our responsibility to protect our kids from the poisons in society. I mentioned in the homily the national resource we have made available here in the *Confident* booklet for every home where kids live or visit regularly. Every adult who cares for kids should review the steps below to see if your home is a safe haven. Or if by neglect you may be allowing porn or unmonitored screen

time to poison the innocence or development of the people in your home. This information is provided for adults to protect youth as well as themselves - anyone may face temptations or addiction to pornography and unhealthy screen use. Follow the instructions for this simple tool.

Practice these three gifts regularly in your life...

Stations of the Cross: Attend and/or pray this every week. Booklets available in the back of the church to take home.

Examination of Conscience: Pick up the age appropriate exams and spend 5 minutes a day as a family looking for God's blessings and recognizing my sins and weaknesses. Schedule time for a good Confession before the end of Lent.

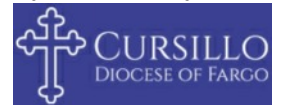
