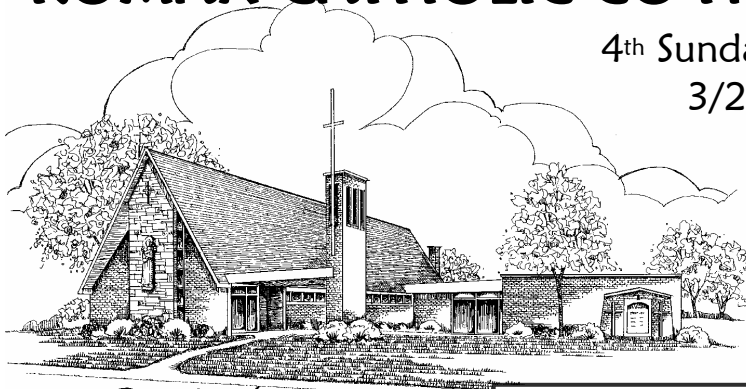


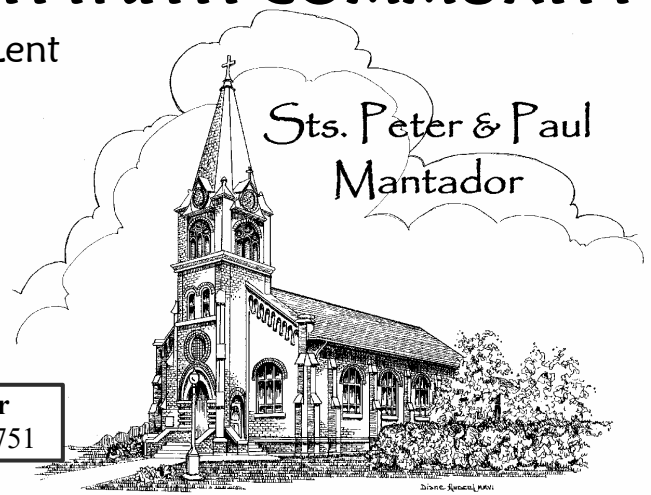

Seeing is believing (sometimes)

From the homily and today's Gospel, this table is one way to recognize how and what we see. We can ask God to open the eyes of our mind and heart to see deeper, more, and truer - to see myself and others as God sees us - not stopping at the appearance. We are called to see as the blind man came to see, recognizing Jesus as God, and to see that it is worth losing everything else for Him, and for the fullness of faith that is meant to reveal the deep, loving, and merciful truth that God is still with us still today in the Eucharist, Scripture, Sacraments, Church, all this is True, Good and Beautiful.
