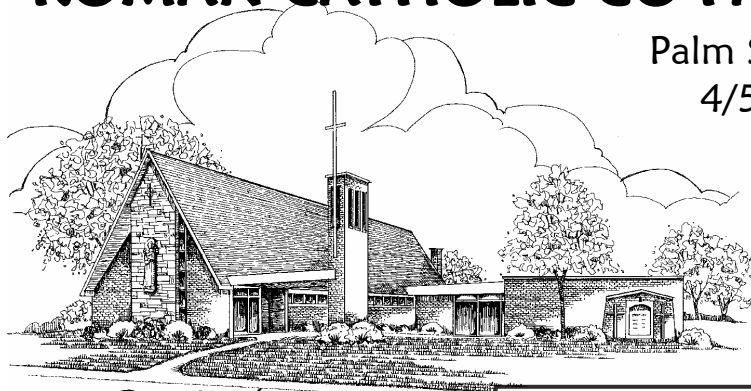
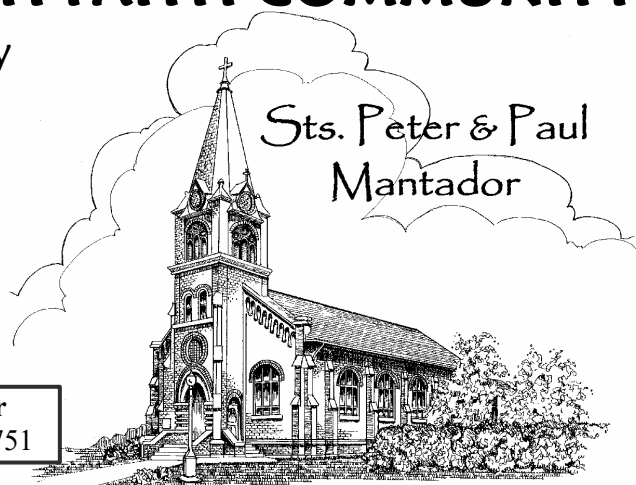

King, Lord, God, Savior

This week we hear the longer Passion story in the Gospels. Read and pray it carefully. What is God saying to you? Is Jesus your king? Your Lord? Your Savior? Your God?

Think carefully about each word, each title. A king has my allegiance, everything I have is by the king's authority. My Lord has my allegiance also, very directly as a master to a slave. Do I admit that I need a savior? My sins lead to hell. I can't save myself or stop myself from the broken, sinful, self-destructive, prideful habits. I need to be saved by God; no one else can save me either. My God! The God-Man Jesus Christ. What an overwhelming and powerful mystery! "I believe, help my unbelief!"

During this Holiest of Weeks, I encourage you once again to stop in the Church for quiet prayer during the week. If you didn't make a space in your house for time with God, I encourage you still to do so. Keep that space; don't plan to take it down like the Christmas tree. Dedicate a little space in your home to God. Set up a candle, religious art (Jesus, saints, etc.), Bible, book of prayers, etc.

I gave two verses last week. I am repeating this one. Repeat it, memorize it. Believe it. Live in this assurance.

Romans 8:37-39 - No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Assignment: Practice the presence of God - Participate in the Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday & Easter Vigil/Sunday morning). Read the Scriptures each day and listen to God speak in and through them. Ask God to

remind you of His presence in every moment, whether joyful, trying, or ordinary.

An Act of Spiritual Communion

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You.

The Lord calls us to love God and to love our neighbor. Every day we are presented with opportunities to love our neighbor and help him "carry his cross." These opportunities aren't usually big events, they are usually ordinary occurrences like helping someone carry their groceries or holding the door open for them. The key is putting the other person's needs before our own and not expecting anything in return.
