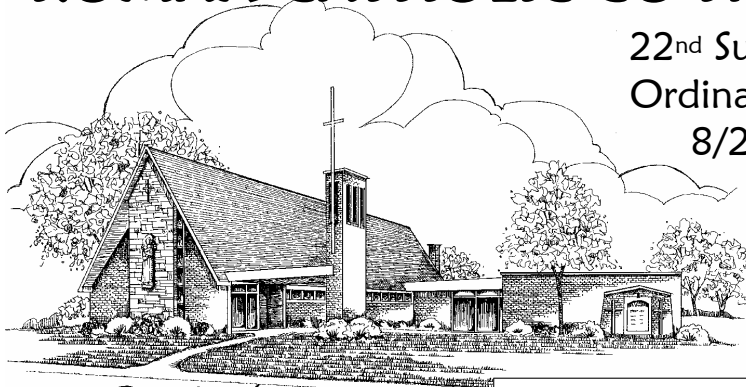


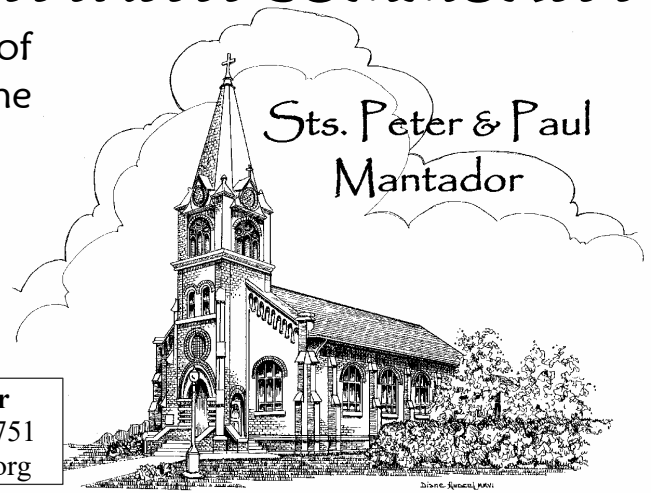

To begin, what do you see just above our parish names? (1) *{Answers at the bottom}*

Next **One Minute Mediations** - short lines leaving us a minute to meditate. This month - Time, Vision, & Sorrow.

The next article challenges us to Perfection - How is that possible? (2)

The section, **Why Do Catholics Do That?** Fits with a couple topics I've touched on this summer. Do I follow God's (10) Commandments or do I pick and choose only what I think to be important? *{Only God and you know that answer.}*

Page 2 starts with another encouraging phrase, **Be not afraid** - What do I fear? What can conquer my fears? (3)

There is always a section on **Scripture** and **Feasts/Celebrations** coming in the month ahead - What theme do you see clearly in the Scripture meditation? These are three of the many saints we celebrate this month. Learn more about them.

Then there is a **Q&A** section and this months question is always being asked by someone, **Why do I have to go to Mass when I don't enjoy it?** What is the main point they include? (4)

I hope you spend a little more time with this packed newsletter every month so that each of us is **Growing in Faith**.

What specific action can I take to show my commitment to remain a disciple of our Lord?

Memorize God's Word: Use James 1:22 from below...

Grow in faith: Don't just talk about God and religion, talk to God and live your faith/religion each day! Read the Bible daily.

Religious Education (RE) & Faith Formation (FF) - Mandatory parent meeting this Wed., Sep 1, at 6:45 pm. At least one parent must attend. The link to the livestream on Zoom was sent to all families via email. Parents are the first and most important witnesses and educators of the faith. We provide the classes for both the social aspect - kids growing in faith with other kids, and for those families who have shared that they could not teach the faith at home. We need **parents or other adults** to be involved as helpers, subs, or even a teacher. Everyone is busy - but are we too busy to share the gift of faith with our kids? Many are scared/nervous about 'teaching' - your loving presence is the most visible lesson. Please let me know how you can help pass on the faith to the children of the parish.
