


Page 2 starts with another encouraging phrase, **Be not afraid** - What do I fear? What can conquer my fears? (3)

(I) A connection - hope, joy are found in faith. (2) Love, obedience, service to God & neighbor. (4) It's about God, not about us.



Memorize God's Word: Use James 1:22 from below...

Grow in faith: Don't just talk about God and religion, talk to God and live your faith/religion each day! Read the Bible daily.

Religious Education (RE) & Faith Formation (FF) - Mandatory parent meeting this Wed., Sep 1, at 6:45 pm. At least one parent must attend. The link to the livestream on Zoom was sent to all families via email. Parents are the first and most important witnesses and educators of the faith. We provide the classes for both the social aspect - kids growing in faith with other kids, and for those families who have shared that they could not teach the faith at home. We need **parents or other adults** to be involved at helpers, subs, or even a teacher. Everyone is busy - but are we too busy to share the gift of faith with our kids? Many are scared/nervous about 'teaching' - your loving presence is the most visible lesson. Please let me know how you can help pass on the faith to the children of the parish.


