Praying for gratitude and hope.

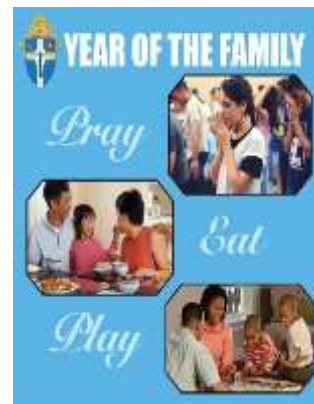
Saints leading us to Jesus.
