ALL SOULS' DAY & THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Traditionally, the faithful may receive a full indulgence each day from Nov. 1 to Nov. 8, particularly on November 2, All Souls' Day, when they visited a cemetery to pray for the departed and fulfill the below conditions. Due to COVID, this year the Vatican Apostolic Penitentiary has extended the full indulgence throughout the entire month of November. Also, those who are ill or homebound and would not be able to physically visit a church or cemetery in the prescribed timeframe still will be able to receive a plenary indulgence when meeting certain conditions.

How to receive the indulgence:

- Demonstrate a resolve to turn away from sin and convert to God.
 - Have a spirit detached from sin
 - go to confession as soon as possible
 - receive the Eucharist as soon as possible
 - pray for the pope's intentions
 - be united spiritually with all the faithful
- Those who visit a church and recite the Our Father and the Creed can also be gained any day in November.
- Those who cannot leave their homes or residence for "serious reasons," may, also receive a plenary indulgence after reciting specific prayers for the deceased, reflecting on a Gospel reading designated for Masses of the dead before an image of Jesus or the Blessed Virgin Mary, or by performing a work of mercy.
- The church teaches that prayer, particularly the Mass, and sacrifices may be offered on behalf of the souls in purgatory.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church says, "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven."
