Confirmation

Holy Cross is revamping the preparation program for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Registration for Confirmation (Grades 7th & 8th and High School) begins this month and **closes on September 22.** To enroll your child, please contact the Church Office.

High School students 9th grade or higher will be enrolled in a one-year program, *Didache*, led by Deacon Kevin. They will receive Confirmation in the Spring of 2022.

Junior High students in 7th or 8th grade will begin a two-year formation program. Natalie Friesenhahn and her team will lead the first-year of formation program *Chosen*. Next year, Deacon Kevin will lead the second-year class *Didache*. Confirmation will be held in the Fall following the completion of the two-year program.

Please note we will have a Confirmation Family Mass at 6:30 pm on Wednesday, September 29.
