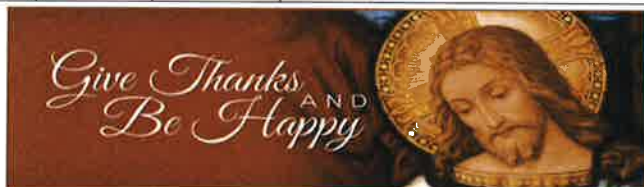

**NOVEMBER INDULGENCES**

Every day throughout the month of November the Church is granting a plenary indulgence that can be applied only to the souls in purgatory. The faithful can receive this indulgence each day to apply to a particular soul — a parent, spouse, relative, friend, or anyone even unknown.

On each day from Nov. 1-30 a person seeking the plenary indulgence for a soul must (1) "devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, if only mentally, for the departed; "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen." (2) on All Souls' Day (or according to the ordinary, on the Sunday preceding it or following it...) devoutly visit a church or an oratory and recite an Our Father and the Creed."

In addition to gain a plenary indulgence you must:

- Be baptized and in the state of grace, at least at the time the indulgenced work is done.
- Have "the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin." Otherwise, the indulgence becomes partial, not plenary.

And fulfill these three conditions:

- Sacramentally confess your sins
- Receive Holy Communion.
- Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father. One Our Father and one Hail Mary fully satisfies this.

(N.B. One sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and separate prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father are required for each plenary indulgence.)
