

STJ Guidelines for Quarantine and Isolation

Any Person, including student, faculty, or staff member who is diagnosed with a COVID-19 infection cannot attend school or school activities for the duration of their isolation. This would include persons being tested for COVID-19 who have quarantined but have not yet received a negative result.

Any student or staff member who is determined to be a close contact of a COVID positive individual will be required to quarantine as follows (a close contact is defined as someone within 6 feet, unmasked, for a duration of 15 or more minutes cumulative in a 24 hour period, or who has participated in a high risk activity with a COVID positive individual, including eating less than 6 feet apart, participating in physical exertion in close proximity, shouting, etc.

- **Vaccinated individuals (with proof of vaccination):** No quarantine is necessary unless the exposed individual is symptomatic.
- **Individuals with proof of a positive for COVID-19 in the past 6 months:** No quarantine is necessary unless the exposed individual is symptomatic.
- **Unvaccinated individuals who are properly masked:** No quarantine is necessary unless the individual is symptomatic.
- **Unvaccinated individuals who are not masked:** Quarantine will be necessary. If this individual is asymptomatic there are two options to leave quarantine early.
- **Option one:** They may take a PCR test on or after day 6 of their quarantine. If this test is negative, they may leave quarantine on day 8 and return to activities.
- **Option two (without testing):** Individuals who are exposed and remain asymptomatic, but do not take a PCR test, must quarantine for 10 days, returning to activities on day 11 after exposure.

Students who are quarantined will be able to get their classwork through Google classroom. There is no option for remote learning this school year.
