**Implementation**

1. Each school (right column, above) should reach out to their partner prior to September 2019. Tell them you would like to partner with them to share our mission work with our youngest Catholics and in your school. Get your partner's feedback on how best to serve them including collecting items, etc. *This is a mutual partnership with a goal of walking alongside one another.* Each location will give as well as receive.
2. Ask your mission partner if they could provide someone to come to your school to speak at an assembly to educate students about their work and their service to the local community. This is a great opportunity for students to learn that our diocese encompasses more than their local school and parish. It's a way to highlight the great needs our neighbors have. (If both mission partners are schools, each should speak to students at the partner's school.)
3. Share the importance of giving back with your students. Please compile a video (one per school) showing your efforts that you can share with the Office of Development. (This does not need to be professional and can be done on your phone.)
  - a. Elementary Students: Create a lesson plan that teaches the values of giving back, utilizing Jesus' parables. Teach giving at their level (for example: be a helper, acts of kindness, etc.).
  - b. Middle School and High School: Ask students to commit to acts of service by volunteering for various organizations, their mission partner, or their own school. Ask each student to commit to 8 hours of service in the month of October. Incorporate lessons explaining who we are as a Mission Diocese and why acts of service (giving back) are important. Highlight your mission partner throughout.
4. Raise money (column on the right) for your mission partner (column on the left). Choose the timeframe to collect funds that works best for you during the month of October. This can be all month or one week. The funds will be directly donated to your mission partner. Please take pictures of your presentations of gifts to share with the Office of Development.
