

Notice of Nondiscriminatory Policy



In keeping with Diocesan policy #3001, the schools under the auspices of the Roman Catholic Diocese of Lexington, KY do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin. This policy states *“No one shall be refused admission to any school program within the jurisdiction of the Diocesan School Council on the grounds of race, color, sex or nationality.”*

Students of any race, color, national or ethnic origin who meet the individual schools' eligibility requirements are admitted to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded to students at that school. Schools do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in administration of educational policies, admission policies, scholarships and tuition-assistance programs, and other school-administered programs. ASBESTOS ANNUAL NOTIFICATION

This notice is to advise parents, teachers, students and all school employees of the Catholic Diocese of Lexington, KY that all Catholic schools of the diocese have been inspected as required by the AHERA federal legislation for the presence of asbestos in school facilities, and are in compliance with both national and state regulations and laws. Micro-Analytics Inc. of Louisville, KY performed the three year re-inspection during the 2019-2020 school year and developed or renewed plans for each school where asbestos content has been identified and made part of a management plan of the school system.

A complete asbestos management plan for the Office of Catholic Schools is on file at the Roman Catholic Diocese of Lexington, KY, 1310 West Main Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40508-2048. A copy of the asbestos management plan for each individual school is on file in the principal's office.

As required by AHERA, in addition to the required three-year inspection noted above, a trained person at each school inspects the conditions of the asbestos twice each year and records the results of this review. Federal regulations are also to be followed in remodeling work that might disturb asbestos-containing materials.

We will continue to inform you at least once each year on the status of the Asbestos Management Plan. Be assured that every precaution will be used to protect the well being of students and employees of schools within the Catholic Diocese of Lexington, KY.

As schools are constructed or renovated, asbestos is removed.
