Committee Reports:

Formation – almost finished for the semester. Reconciliation will take place Dec. 10 and 11. The 2nd grade class is large so we needed to divide it. Currently will have 11 making their First Communion. Certification program for teachers: Susette is in the process of completing two classes on line and will then only have one class to complete in the spring to have her certification done.
