

Parish Council Meeting

Monday, September 12, 2016

Dan Connell opened the meeting. Mary Berglee provided the prayer and thank you cards for Cindi Russell and Bill Grimes.

Susette Redwine reported on the opening weekend for Formation classes. We had 33 in attendance. Currently we have 3 individuals receiving Confirmation instruction. We have been advertising that others have not been confirmed, they should contact us. VBS went well. Numbers were about 24. Still looking for volunteers to do Children's Liturgy during Mass.

Michelle Hardin reported for the Social Concerns Committee. Chili Wars is happening on October 1 in support of God's Food Pantry. All the items needed have been donated. Still have to plan decorating the table. Sept. 14 there will be a meeting. Going to start towards the end of September on list of items for the Thanksgiving Baskets. Will work with Susette on getting items from CCD classes.

Mary Berglee reported that the Liturgy Committee needs to meet. Fr. Noel went over the Mass schedule. Sign-up for Ministries have taken place. Servers training will be held soon. Dan will train the Eucharistic Ministers and Travis Lockhart will train the Lectors.

Taylor Brown reported that things are progressing with the Newman Center. Mary Jane is assisting with activities for Darinda. Meals are averaging around 15 in attendance. Still need people to provide meals. The Knights will be providing meals on the 20th. Publicizing the Student Mass was discussed. Taylor has plans for that. Tyler will be Taylor's replacement in January. Taylor's last meeting will be in November.
