

### **Points for Reopening**

- 1) The doors to the church will only be opened 20 minutes prior to the start of Mass.
- 2) If you are feeling sick, please stay home. What follows for points 3 through 7 are taken from The State Guidelines pertaining to Places of Worship.
- 3) A Place of Worship, shall communicate to its members and workers that if they are feeling sick, are exhibiting any of the following symptoms (fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell), or have potentially been exposed to someone with confirmed or suspected COVID-19, then they should not attend services in-person.
- 4) A potential exposure means having household contact or having close contact (within 6 feet) with an individual with confirmed or suspected COVID-19 for a prolonged period of time (over 10 minutes) while the person is symptomatic or 48 hours before symptoms developed.)
- 5) If someone attends mass and becomes COVID positive, it would be very much appreciated if the parish was notified, that is Fr. Michael, Laura Petkewich, or Betty Hudson, so we can report and make parishioners aware someone who attended the same mass as you have tested positive. In this way, we can assure your privacy.
- 6) If a place of worship learns that an individual with COVID-19 attended a service or otherwise entered the place of worship, it shall conduct a deep cleaning and disinfecting consistent with the Centers for Disease Control guidance:

- 7) If a Place of worship learns that an attendee or worker or other worker has tested positive for COVID-19, it shall notify the local Board of Health (LBOH) in the city or town where the place of worship is located and assist the LBOH as reasonably requested to trace likely contacts and advise contacts to isolate and self-quarantine.
- 8) The Collection Basket will be at the front doors of the church as you exit. This also may be the time to activate on-line giving through your bank, credit card or our web site.
- 9) Gathering in the parking lot after mass will be up to you as long as you maintain the six feet of social distancing.
- 10) Once everyone has left the building the doors will be locked, and disinfecting will begin. The doors will remain locked. The church doors will be opened 20 minutes before each mass. After the 10:00 mass, the same procedure will be done, and the doors will be locked until 20 minutes before the 6:00 pm mass after which the same procedure will happen. For those who wish to visit during the weekdays, an area of the church will be set aside for prayer from the hours of 9:00 am to Noon time, and that area will be disinfected.
